Rev. Christian Watkins is the Executive Director/Campus Pastor at Ecumenical Campus Ministry (ECM) at Kansas State University (KSU) in Manhattan, Kan. She teaches in the School of Education and Human Sciences at the University of Kansas (KU).

Rev. Watkins graduated from Yale Divinity School and was ordained in

the Christian Church (DOC) in 2014. She also has ministerial standing in the UCC and serves in a Presbyterian Church (PCUSA) ministry. Her ministry passions include fostering alternative faith communities, spiritual mentorship, creative liturgies, interbelief solidarity and supplying abundant enthusiasm. A member of the Anti-Racism Team for the Kansas DOC, she is committed to anti-racist and inclusive LGBTQ+ institutional practices.

A dedicated humanitarian, Christian has a passion for welcoming and affirming the experiences of immigrants and refugees. She currently serves as a core team member of the Manhattan Afghan Resettlement Team (MART) in Kansas where she co-coordinates resettlement efforts both locally and state-wide. She previously served with Global Ministries in Turkey focusing on long-term refugee resettlement efforts. She approaches the lifelong process of resettlement through mutual relationship, community-advocacy, and deep cultural respect.
