ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To apply, candidates must:

- Be a graduate of Centrum PUCP Master's program.
- Submit the required documentation: passport, transcript, diploma, photo, CV, language test (if applicable), insurance, and others.
- Complete the application and pay the program fee (€4,950)

Selected participants will receive an official letter of acceptance and student ID from the University of Bordeaux.

Minimum cohort: 15 students (combined among all consortium institutions).

You can start your process now. Candidates must send their request and documents before October 15, 2025.
