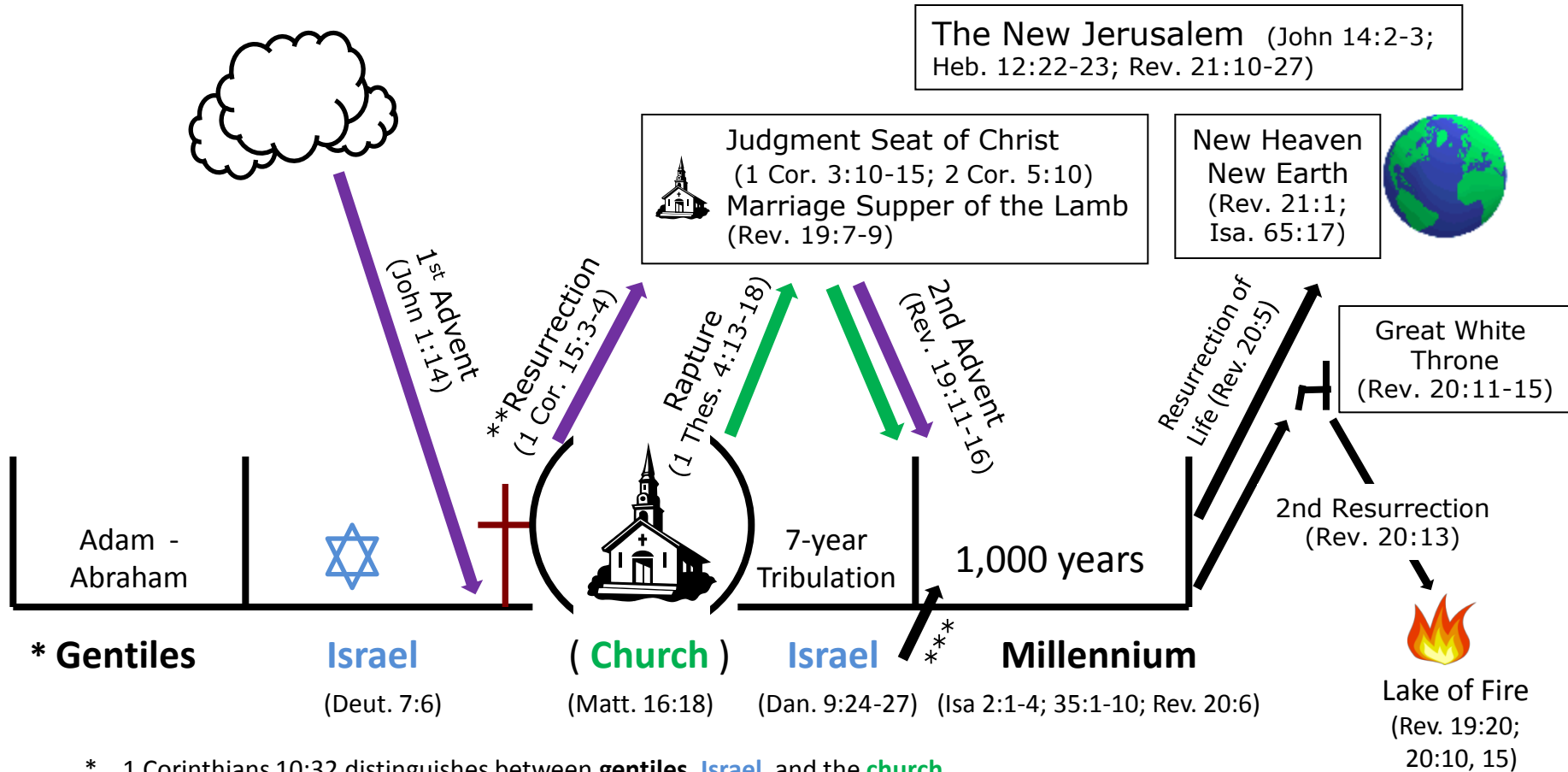
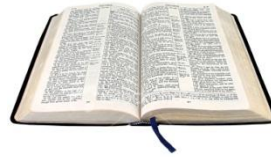


TIME LINE OF THE BIBLE

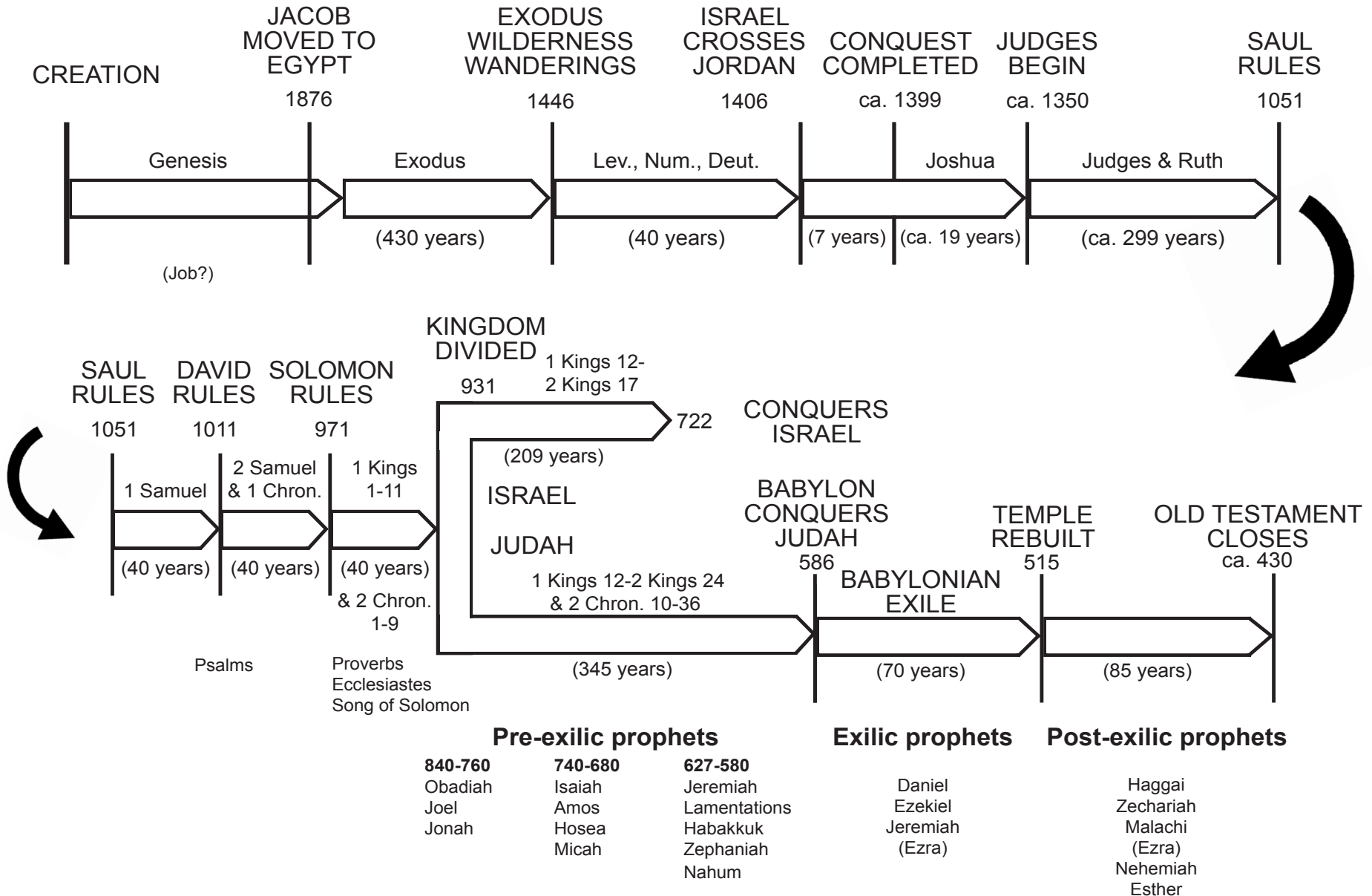


* 1 Corinthians 10:32 distinguishes between **gentiles**, **Israel**, and the **church**

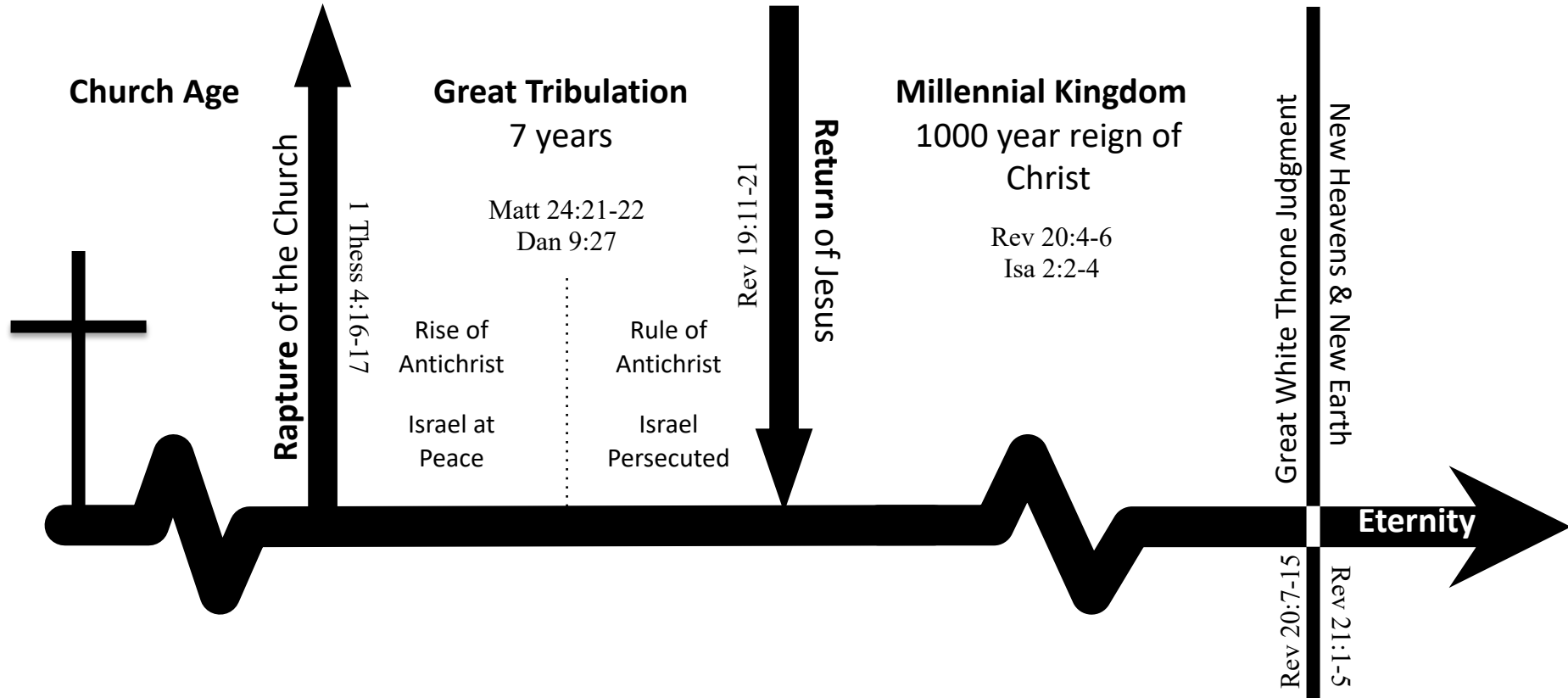
** 1 Corinthians 15:23 refers to order of the First Resurrection, beginning with Christ, the first fruits

- 1. Purification/Conversion of Israel
- 2. Judgment on the Nations

Seven Seal Judgments

- 1. Deception
- 2. War
- 3. Famine
- 4. Death
- 5. Martyrdom
- 6. Divine Wrath
- 7. Trumpets

Seven Trumpet Judgments

- 1. 1/3 of Vegetation Destroyed
- 2. 1/3 of Sea Creatures and Ships Destroyed
- 3. 1/3 of Rivers & Springs Bitter, Many Die
- 4. 1/3 of Sun, Moon, and Stars Struck
- 5. FIRST WOE: Locusts Sent to Torment Humanity
- 6. SECOND WOE: Four Angels with an Army of Two Hundred Million, Killing a 1/3 of Humanity
- 7. THIRD WOE: Victory of Christ and His Kingdom Proclaimed

Seven Bowl Judgments

- 1. Sores on those who worshipped the beast and his image
- 2. Sea turns to blood; all sea creatures die
- 3. Rivers and springs turn to blood
- 4. Humanity scorched by the sun
- 5. Pain and darkness upon the beast and his kingdom.
- 6. Euphrates dried up, three unclean spirits gather the kingdoms of the earth for the battle at Armageddon
- 7. Great earthquake, the great city divided, Babylon is remembered, cataclysmic events
