What Can Jesus Do?

Fifth week in the series: The Mystery of Christ
Ephesians 3:1-13

In his letter to the Ephesians, Paul has been building up to this. There's a mystery that he reveals in Ephesians 3:1-13. He calls it "the mystery of Christ." Well, what is it?

Discussion Questions:

1. If you are a believer in Jesus, you are a "prisoner of Christ," which means you're free to follow Christ. How do you think you have felt free to follow Christ?
2. If you are a believer in Jesus Christ, you are a fellow heir, a fellow member of the body of Christ, a fellow partaker of the promise in Christ Jesus, along with all other believers. What does this mean to you?
3. The gospel not only saves us as individuals, it also incorporates us into the worldwide, multiethnic, eternal people of God. What does this mean to you?
4. The gospel conveys the "unsearchable riches in Christ," though Paul describes, as best he can, some of those riches in the book of Ephesians. Insofar as you are able to understand those riches, what do they mean to you?
5. Describe your experience of worshiping together with others.
