Living out the Gospel in Community

Seventh week in the series: Under the Cross

1 Corinthians 6:1-11

Living life in community is beautiful, but it can also be challenging. What do we do when we are wronged by one of our brothers and sisters in Christ? The answer must begin with rooting ourselves in the finished work of Christ so that we can live out the gospel in community.

Discussion Questions:

1. How do you tend to deal with conflict? Do you find yourself responding to conflict differently in different contexts (e.g. work, family, friends, etc)?
2. How do you respond when you are wronged by someone? How would you like to respond?
3. In verse 7, Paul calls us to accept wrongdoing from others without responding in kind or fighting for our well-being. How does this reflect the teachings of Jesus? What is a situation in which you might practice that?
4. How does Jesus' work on the cross empower us to respond to others with grace and love when we are wronged?!
