3. What do you think are the implications for caring more about having something to boast about than the cross of Jesus Christ? Conversely, what do you think are the implications for caring more about the cross of Jesus Christ than having something to boast about?
4. If you have given your allegiance to Christ, then you are a new creation; you are part of the church of Jesus Christ, which is a new creation; and you will inherit the new creation. How do you think these truths could affect the way we live?
