

The Invitation to Discipleship

Passage: Luke 5:1-11 | Week 7 in the series: Luke

Date: For the week of 2/15/26

An encounter with Jesus can move us from simply listening to him to reorienting our entire lives around him. Luke 5 invites us to consider what it looks like to step out of the crowd and into a life shaped by trust, confession, and participation in his mission.

Discussion Questions:

1. In this passage, Peter moves from being part of the crowd to becoming a disciple. Where do you see yourself right now — mostly observing Jesus from the crowd, or actively following him? What makes you say that?
2. Peter obeys Jesus with a simple step of trust before he fully understands who Jesus is. What might be one “baby step” of obedience Jesus is inviting you to take right now?
3. When Peter encounters Jesus’ power and holiness, he becomes aware of his own sin and need. How have moments of encountering God helped you see yourself more clearly?
4. Jesus calls Peter not only to follow him but to join his mission of reaching others. What might it look like for you to join Jesus’ mission in your everyday life — at work, at home, or in your neighborhood?
