## Discussion Questions:

2. What do you think makes wealth spiritually dangerous? How might wealth subtly shape the way someone relates to God?
3. How does Jesus' description of blessing and woe challenge the way you typically define a "good life" or a "blessed life"?
4. Where do you see the tension in your life between self-sufficiency and dependence on God? What tends to push you toward one or the other?
5. How might this passage reshape the way you relate to the poor and suffering—not just in what you give, but in how you see and learn from them?
