3. What do you make of this story from Jesus, and how do you respond to it? “A certain moneylender had two debtors. One owed five hundred denarii, and the other fifty. When they could not pay, he cancelled the debt of both. Now which of them will love him more?”
4. Think of someone, or certain kinds of people, that you have a difficult time with and hear Jesus ask you this question: “Do you see this woman [this man, these people]?” What does the question provoke in you?
5. How do you relate, or not relate, to the woman in this narrative?
