Discussion Questions:

1. The disciples ended up in the storm because they followed Jesus into the boat (Luke 8:22-23). Why do we sometimes assume that following Jesus should protect us from storms? How does this passage challenge that assumption?
2. When the disciples woke Jesus, they cried out, “Master, Master, we are perishing!” What kinds of circumstances tend to make you feel like Jesus is absent, asleep, or not acting quickly enough?
3. The storm revealed both the disciples’ fear and their faith—they were afraid, but they still went to Jesus. What do your reactions during difficult seasons reveal about where your faith naturally goes?
4. After calming the storm, Jesus asks, “Where is your faith?” When has a storm in your life caused you to “forget” your faith? And how have challenges deepened your faith?
5. The disciples end by asking, “Who then is this?” How does seeing Jesus as both present with us and powerful over the storm change the way we face trials?
