Discussion Questions:

2. If you can sense in you a tendency to "justify" yourself, describe this sense.
3. The narrative, and the parable within the narrative, challenges us in three ways. Describe your reaction to each of these:
 - a. The parable challenges us to receive mercy from Jesus.
 - b. The parable challenges us to show mercy to others.
 - c. The parable challenges us to learn mercy even from enemies.
