

Rich Towards God

Passage: Luke 12:13-21 | From the series: *Luke*

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What calls for your attention in life? Responsibilities? Desires? Routine maintenance of life? These easily lock our focus on this world - what we want from it and what it requires in return. Yet, as Jesus redirects our attention to an eternal life with God, how does that affect how we approach our resources, responsibility, and purpose?

Discussion Questions:

1. What does it look like for you to be rich towards God?
2. What stops you from being generous with your time, resources, and attitude?
3. If all that we have and are is a gift from God, what does it mean to be stewards instead of owners? How might that shift in attitude change how we manage what we are given?
4. Are there areas of your life you can identify greed, coveting, selfishness, or jealousy? Take a moment to surrender those to God.
5. Take a moment to pray. Is there an area that God is prompting you to invest more into your relationship with Him or invest more into eternal things?
