

CORPS OF CADETS SCHOLARSHIPS



Though there are many ways to make a personalized gift, you can support a member of the Corps of Cadets through one of four key scholarships:

- 1.** Corps of Cadets 1876 Scholarship
- 2.** Corps of Cadets 21st Century Scholarship
- 3.** General Rudder Corps Scholarship
- 4.** Sul Ross Scholarship

You can also choose to create a future Corps Scholarship through one of many planned giving options. While most scholarships are named after the donors who give them, you may also choose to name your scholarship in memory or honor of another person, class or organization. Once funded, these scholarships provide a student with a yearly stipend for up to four years, after which a new cadet will begin to benefit from your gift.

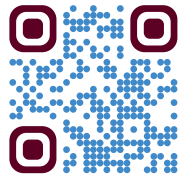
By funding Corps of Cadets scholarships, your gift creates a financially-even playing field where membership in the Corps is no longer cost-prohibitive for cadets in comparison to their traditional student counterparts. This support makes the Corps of Cadets a more feasible option for its members and positively impacts their academic experience and success in Aggieland.



Four key ways to support students in the Corps of Cadets:

1. **Corps of Cadets 1876 Scholarships** celebrate and honor the Corps' enduring heritage in producing leaders of character. Recipients of this scholarship must maintain a minimum 3.0 overall GPA. You can fund a Corps 1876 Scholarship with a **\$150,000 endowment*** and defray the cost of tuition and expenses by \$6,000 per year.
2. **Corps of Cadets 21st Century Scholarships** ensure that future generations of our nation's leaders continue to come from Texas A&M. Recipients of this scholarship must maintain a minimum 3.0 overall GPA. You can fund a Corps 21 Scholarship with a **\$100,000 endowment*** and defray the cost of tuition and expenses by \$4,000 per year.
3. **General Rudder Corps Scholarships** encourage outstanding students with a high potential for success to commit to learning leadership in the Corps. Recipients of this scholarship must maintain a minimum 2.5 overall GPA. You can fund a General Rudder Corps Scholarship with a **\$50,000 endowment*** and defray the cost of tuition and expenses by \$2,000 per year.
4. **Sul Ross Scholarships** are awarded to deserving students with financial need. Recipients of this scholarship must maintain a minimum 2.3 overall GPA. You can fund a Sul Ross Scholarship with a **\$25,000 endowment*** and defray the cost of tuition and expenses by \$1,000 per year.

Additionally, you can create a customized scholarship of your own design rather than give through one of the existing Corps programs. Custom scholarships can be created with an endowed gift of \$25,000 or more.*

** Scholarships are payable over a five-year period and may be funded with gifts of cash, securities, real estate or corporate matching gifts.*
