## Fund an EOA

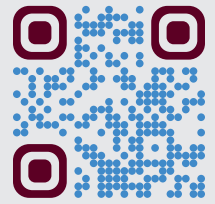
An individual or group can establish an EOA with a \$25,000 gift payable over a five-year period. You can also create a future EOA through a planned gift. EOA gifts to the Foundation are tax-deductible and may be made in the form of cash, securities, real estate or corporate matching gifts. You can also choose to name an EOA in memory or honor of a person, class or organization.

This scholarship provides a student with a four-year award. Every four years, a new student will benefit from your scholarship.
