

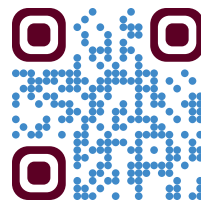
FOUNDATION EXCELLENCE AWARD

By helping remove financial barriers, these scholarships enable hard-working, qualified U.S. residents who gain admittance to Texas A&M University the opportunity to turn their Aggie dreams into reality. Since the program's launch, FEAs have helped thousands of students become leaders of character while helping fulfill Texas A&M's land-grant mission to provide a quality education to a broad cross-section of the population. This in turn creates a more enriching campus experience for the entire student body and strengthens the state and national workforce through a variety of perspectives.

Fund an FEA

An individual, group or corporation can establish an endowed FEA scholarship with a \$50,000 gift payable over a five-year period. Endowed gifts benefit students in perpetuity, and a new student will benefit from your scholarship every four years. You can also fund a one-time FEA scholarship for a single student with a \$10,000 gift or create a future FEA through an after-lifetime gift in your will or living trust.

Your FEA can be personalized to mirror your passions. For example, you can choose to benefit students in specific majors or groups, such as engineering majors or those participating in the Corps of Cadets, and you can support undergraduate students at the College Station or Galveston campuses.

FEA gifts to the Foundation are tax deductible and may be made in the form of cash, securities, real estate or corporate matching gifts. You can also name an FEA in memory or honor of a person, class or organization.
