

PRESIDENT'S ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP



Encourage gifted minds to fulfill their dreams

Since 1968, the President's Endowed Scholarship (PES) has been Texas A&M's flagship program to attract high-achieving students who bring distinction to Texas A&M through their accomplishments. These students invigorate the academic and social climate on campus and benefit society with their ambitions.

More than 1,000 students attend Texas A&M with help from these scholarships. To be considered, Texas A&M Scholarships and Financial Aid will review academic achievement, campus and community activities, leadership roles and employment. Financial need is not considered for this scholarship.

The PES program helps Texas A&M recruit and retain its most promising scholars—students who are pursued by other top universities and who are eager to work toward their limitless potential. Because these scholarships are endowed, they will support Texas A&M students forever.

Fund a President's Endowed Scholarship

An individual or group can establish a PES with a \$100,000 gift payable over a five-year period. You can also create a future PES through a planned gift. PES gifts to the Foundation are tax-deductible and may be made in the form of cash, securities, real estate or corporate matching gifts. You can also choose to name a PES in memory or honor of a person, class or organization.

This scholarship provides a student with a four-year award, plus eligibility for an education abroad stipend. Every four years, a new student will benefit from your scholarship. PES recipients who are not Texas residents can waive their out-of-state tuition while attending Texas A&M.

Leave a Legacy

The PES program allows you to develop relationships with current Aggie students. You will have the opportunity to meet your scholars and other donors at an annual on-campus celebration. If you choose to establish a PES, you will also become a member of the Texas A&M Legacy Society. Your gift will further be recognized on a master plaque in the Memorial Student Center, and you will receive a plaque honoring the person for whom the scholarship is named.
