Support **first-generation Aggie students**

The Regents' Scholars Program was created in 2003 to help students who will become the first in their families to obtain college degrees. Almost 2,000 Regents' Scholars are pursuing their college dreams at Texas A&M University; 90% of them remain on the scholarship until graduation. First-generation undergraduates whose total family income is less than \$40,000 per year are eligible for the Regents' Scholars Program.

In addition to financial support, the program provides academic and social assistance, on campus living their freshman year, a learning community and an orientation with continuing Regents' Scholars. Texas A&M touches many lives through the Regents' Scholars Program, making the dream of a college education possible for approximately 600 new Aggies every year. Because Regents' Scholarships are endowed, they will support first-generation Aggies forever.

Fund a Regents' Scholarship

An individual or group can establish a Regents' Scholarship with a \$100,000 gift payable over a five-year period. You can also create a future scholarship through a planned gift. Gifts to the Foundation are tax-deductible and may be made in the form of cash, securities, real estate, or corporate matching gifts. You can also name your scholarship in memory or honor of a person, class or organization.

Regents' Scholarships provide students with a four-year award. Every four years, a new student will benefit from your scholarship.

Leave a Legacy

The Regents' Scholars Program allows you to develop relationships with students to share ideas and dreams. You will have the opportunity to meet your scholars and other donors at an annual on-campus spring banquet. If you choose to establish a Regents' Scholarship, your gift will also be recognized on a master plaque in the Pavilion on the Texas A&M campus.
