

Regular City Council Meeting

April 19, 2021

Mayor Karlin opened the meeting at 7:00PM and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Woehler gave the Invocation.

Councilman Thomasson moved to approve the minutes of the 4/5/2021 Public Hearing and Regular City Council Meeting, seconded by Councilman Ferguson. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Council.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mery Donald, representing Montana on a Mission, asked the Council for permission to use the parking lot of the City Hall for registration and to gather after the run. It will start at approximately 7:30 AM and finish around 9:30 or 10:00 AM and to approve the route of the run which is the same route that has been used in the past. Councilman Ferguson moved to approve the Sweet Grass Fest Fun Run route and the use of the Parking lot at City Hall, seconded by Councilman Woehler. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Council.

Judge Jessie Connolly wanted to give some information and to ask the Council to revisit the Interlocal Agreement, Justice of the Peace/City Judge. The interlocal agreement that was adopted Jan. 1, 2018 does not allow for annual budget discussion. Judge Connolly is asking the Council to amend this agreement so that budget discussions can take place before the four year agreement has expired. The City Clerk will put Judge Connolly on the agenda for the first meeting in May for a more detailed budget discussion.

Councilman Rockeman moved to approve the 1st Quarter Pledged Securities, seconded by Councilman Thomasson. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Council.

Councilman Thomasson moved to approve RESOLUTION #999 A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2020 CITY-COUNTY SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS, seconded by Councilman Rockeman. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Council.

Councilman Woehler moved to approve the claims list for the 2nd half of March 2021, seconded by Councilman Ferguson. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Council.

Councilman Thomasson moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:35 PM, seconded by Councilman Rockeman. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Council.
