

21-22 BUDGET WORK MEETING

JUNE 3, 2021

Mayor Karlin, opened the meeting at 7:00pm and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Ferguson gave the Invocation.

Councilman Rockeman started the discussion by informing the Council of a meeting that was held with the Animal Control Officer/Fire Admin Assistant, Public Works Director and the City Clerk. The Animal Control Officer's job was discussed. Questions were raised regarding the job description and what exactly is expected. Would a full-time job be warranted or would it be okay for the Officer to work overtime? Is the Animal Control Officer/Fire Admin Assistant job considered a full-time job or two part-time jobs? The Clerk was asked to find out from MMIA if the Council can stipulate only having five hours of overtime per week and then the rest over 45 hours be considered comp time. Also, if the Animal Control comp time can be used for the Fire Admin. part of the job?

The City Employee Wage Matrix was discussed. It was decided that the Clerk will add some steps and come up with several possibilities.

The Clerk reminded the Council of the meeting scheduled with the County Commissioners on Thursday, June 10<sup>th</sup> at 1:00pm. The City/County shared budget will be discussed and it would also be a good time to go over the City/County Interlocal Agreements.
