Council: Kerri Baird, Jeff Davis, Justin Ferguson, and Leonard Woehler.



FY26 Budget Discussion: Wages for city employees were discussed and the Council consensus was to give a 2.9% raise to the employees. Clerk/Treasurer, Hope Mosness, went over the Revenue Budget for FY26 and also presented property tax information and scenarios for this coming year. The next budget meeting will be held on Monday, July 7, at 6pm.

Public Comment: Linda Brunckhorst agreed that a 2.9% increase to the employee wages was fair. She asked if the pool fund could be used to pay for part of the cost of the pool liner. She also encouraged the Council to look at small increases like 2-3% on water and sewer rates rather than doing a large increase all at once.

Councilman Ferguson made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:22pm, seconded by Councilman Davis. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Council.
