

Budget Work Meeting and Special City Council Meeting

Mayor DeBoer opened the Budget Work Meeting at 6:00pm and led the group in the pledge of allegiance.

FY26 Budget Discussion: Public Works Director, Kris Novotny, presented his expenditure budget. City Clerk/Treasurer, Hope Mosness went over the remaining expenditure budget. Wages will be discussed at the next Budget Work Meeting on June 30, 2025.

Public Comment: None

Mayor DeBoer closed the Budget Work Meeting at 7:25pm and opened the Special City Council Meeting.

Jim Lippert presented the Memorandum of Understanding for the Whistle Creek property. He stated that while it is not a binding contract it states that the city will cooperate in good faith on the Whistle Creek project. Public Comment: Lee Andreas asked the cost of hiring someone to locate the line. Linda Brunckhorst asked how long the lines have been there and if there is something in the law that states because the line has always been there, if it would keep them from digging up the line. Mike Duval asked for the diameter and distance of the pipe on the Whistle Creek property. Councilwoman Baird made a motion to approve the Whistle Creek Memorandum of Understanding, seconded by Councilman Ferguson. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Council present.

Public Comment: Linda Brunckhorst stated that there is an ongoing problem with the pool and the water aerobics ladies are complaining that it is too cold. She stated she hasn't been back in weeks because it is too cold. They are upset because they have purchased a gym membership and a pool pass but half of them have dropped out because it is too cold. She recommended that the city turn up the temperature.

Councilman Ferguson made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:45pm, seconded by Councilman Davis. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Council present.
