FY26 Budget Discussion: The Council went through both Revenue and Expenditure budgets for FY27.

Mayor Ferguson asked the Council to authorize Kris Novotny to purchase an animal control vehicle. He explained what happened to the current vehicle. There is \$15,000 in the Animal Control Capital Reserve Fund. Councilman Duval suggested increasing the budget to \$20,000 to get a car with less miles. The Council agreed that they do not want a car with a turbo charged engine. They asked the mayor to communicate with Kris their specifications of a vehicle. Councilman Davis made a motion to authorize Kris Novotny, the Public Works Director a budget of \$20,000 to purchase an animal control vehicle with no turbo and a 4-cylinder, seconded by Councilwoman Baird. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Council.
