

ORDINANCE NO. 491

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING REGULATIONS TO INCLUDE FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS IN THE HIGHWAY BUSINESS ZONING DISTRICT AS A PERMITTED CONDITIONAL USE ON PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF BIG TIMBER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BIG TIMBER, MONTANA

That Section 11-9-3 Permitted Conditional Use of Title 11 of the Big Timber City Code be amended to include the words FOOD PROCESSING PLANT.

11-9-3 Conditional Uses:


13. Food Processing Plant

This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after the second and final adoption. Once adopted, the City Attorney is instructed to prepare sheets for insertion into the official City code books. As codified into the official city code books, the above section shall contain parenthetical information stating the ordinance number of passage and the effective date.


