John Ward Road at Irwin Road

Project No. X2802 School Zone Safety & Operational Improvements

The project will construct a single-lane roundabout at the intersection of John Ward Road and Irwin Road. Project scope comprises improvements at the Cheatham Hill Elementary School driveway on John Ward Road, including a new left-turn lane for the school and raised concrete islands to better facilitate school vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

Other area improvements include curb and gutter where currently lacking on John Ward Road, with sidewalks being added along the west side of John Ward Road south of Irwin Road and along the east side of John Ward Road north of Irwin Road. Area street lights will be upgraded to new LED lights at the roundabout and school driveway.

Project Quick Facts

- Joint project with the Cobb County School District
- Estimated start of construction: Late 2017
- Expected completion: August 2018
- Project length: Approximately 0.25 miles along John Ward Road; approximately 300 feet along Irwin Road
- Project selected due to safety and operational concerns confirmed by traffic study
- Funded as part of Cobb County's 2016 Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) and the Cobb County School District's SPLOST IV
