

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MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the Difference Between Medicare and Medicaid?

Medicare is the Federal health insurance program for people 65 years of age or older and certain disabled people. Your local Social Security Administration office takes applications for Medicare and provides general information about their program.

Medicaid is a medical assistance program jointly financed by the State and Federal governments for eligible low-income individuals. Medicaid coverage and eligibility vary among states, and eligibility depends on both financial and non-financial criteria.

What is the Difference Between Dementia and Alzheimer's?

Dementia is not a disease, but is a syndrome marked by deterioration in intellectual performance that involves memory loss and is severe enough to interfere with work or social activities or both. There is almost always a loss of problem-solving ability and other aspects of abstract thinking as well. Alzheimer's disease (AD) is the most common form of dementia.

The earliest symptom of Alzheimer's disease is usually short-term memory loss. Other symptoms may include problems with learning, attention, judgment, orientation, difficulty in finding the right word, and changes in personality and behavior. There are two points to keep in mind: 1) the majority of elderly persons who exhibit symptoms of dementia will turn out to have AD, 2) there are other causes of dementia symptoms that may be treatable and curable. Thus, every person with these symptoms deserves a thorough medical investigation by a physician who is familiar with dementia and the elderly.

What Services are Provided For Seniors Needing Extra Care at Home?

In-home care provides individuals with a wide variety of supportive services that enable them to remain in their own home. In-home care allows patients to be discharged from hospitals earlier than expected because any remaining treatments can be performed in the home. Services include any combination of home health care including medical equipment, respite care (offers relief to caregivers from demands of providing ongoing care), homemaker services, heavy duty chore services, licensed nurses, therapists and social workers, monitoring medications, assistance with the activities of daily living, home-delivered meals, companion services, telephone reassurance, and emergency response systems. Services can be hourly, weekly, monthly, or by any other arrangement. For information regarding care in Cobb County, contact Cobb Senior Services' Information & Referral line at 770-528-5364.

Home health/skilled services are prescribed by a physician, and implemented by a home health care agency. They include physical therapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, intravenous therapy, wound care and dressing, catheterization and injections, and respite. Medicare provides limited coverage for these skilled services. Home care under Medicare Part B is limited in many cases.

What Care is Available Outside the Home?

Look under categories: HOSPITALS, HOSPICE CARE, HOUSING OPTIONS, AND HOUSING SERVICES.

Adult day care/day respite usually provides a structured program with activities, lunch, health and rehabilitative services, occasional outings, family support and/or counseling, and transportation. Clients must meet eligibility requirements.

Independent living is for people who are able to live independently, and prefer to live in a community with others of the same age and with similar interests. An independent retirement community allows for a variety of social activities and trips. Many independent living communities also offer prepared meals and provide a wide range of amenities.

Retirement communities are also known as continuing care or life care communities. The primary advantage of retirement communities is that an individual or couple does not need to relocate if circumstances related to their health change. Because of the breadth of care available, they are generally more costly than the other forms of available residential care. Most elders finance this by the sale of a home.

Continued...MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS -

Personal care homes (assisted living facilities) provide housing in a group setting for elderly or disabled individuals. The Office of Regulatory Services must license personal care homes. They are sometimes given names that include the phrase "assisted living/personal care homes." These facilities provide 24-hour watchful oversight and generally offer staffing and a level of care between independence and that offered by a nursing home. Each facility is required to post its last inspection report for review. If there are questions about this report contact the **Office of Regulatory Services**, Personal Care Home Section at **(404) 657-4076.**

Skilled Nursing Facilities (nursing homes) offer a protective, therapeutic environment for those individuals who require rehabilitative care or can no longer live independently because of a chronic physical or mental condition which requires around-the-clock skilled nursing care. These communities provide care similar to that received in the hospital. Communities that receive Medicaid and Medicare reimbursements are required to maintain a social service staff and provide daily social activities for residents. If there are questions about this report contact the **Office of Regulatory Services**, Personal Care Home Section at **(404) 657-4076**.

Hospice care provides services at home or at a health care community for terminally ill residents and their families. Care is usually supervised by the family's physician working cooperatively with a team of professionals that include nurses, social workers, clergy, and home health care aides. Hospice care primarily manages pain and discomfort, creating an environment that encourages individuals as well as loved ones to openly grieve, talk, grow, and enjoy each other while remaining physically and emotionally close until the end. A person does not usually enter hospice care until given a terminal diagnosis by a physician.

WELCOME TRAVELERS

Cobb Senior Services provides a variety of day trip opportunities. Our goal is to take the hassle out of driving, making reservations, or even traveling alone, so that you can relax and make the most out of your travel experience.

REGISTRATION OPTIONS

Walk-in registration is available at all Cobb Senior Centers Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. Registration for all trips is on a first come, first served basis. Full payment is due at the time of registration. If a trip is full, please ask staff to add your name to the waitlist. When a space becomes available, it will be filled from the waitlist in the order that names were listed.

PRICING

Price includes transportation, admission, snacks, all taxes and tips, and (in most cases) meals. See advertisements for specific details.

TRIP DISCOUNT

Senior Citizens Council of Cobb County, a private, non-profit senior advocacy organization, offers an annual membership to all senior citizens. Benefits of membership include a \$5 discount on all CSS sponsored trips and 12 issues of The Bulletin, a monthly publication which highlights events and activities throughout CSS.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Payment is due at the time of registration. **Cobb Senior Services** accepts the following forms of payment: Cash, Check or Money Order (payable to **CSS**), Visa, American Express, Discover, or MasterCard.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Refunds may take up to 6 weeks to process. Participants who cancel due to medical emergencies may receive a credit on their account, if approved by the center's Coordinator.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Age Requirements – Active adults 55 years or better may participate in day trips. Adults under 55 can participate if they are accompanying a traveler 55 and over, or if a traveler requires special assistance.

Emergency Forms – Every participant must complete an emergency form that includes pertinent information such as medications, allergies, and emergency contact.

Staff – A staff member from Cobb Senior Services accompanies each trip to address any issues that may arise. Travelers are responsible for handling their own personal items/belongings.

Participant Mobility – Each traveler must be able to navigate on and off the bus independently. If you have any concerns with walking or climbing stairs, please check with staff before registering.

Activity Level Scale

<u>Level 1</u> – Small Distance walking, most of trip is seated.

Level 2 - Limited walking, some stairs and/or inclines.

Level 3 - Longer walking, many stairs and /or inclines.

<u>Level 4</u> – Long period of walking, many stairs and/or inclines, limited seated breaks.

Dietary Restrictions – Before registering for a trip, please consult with staff concerning any special dietary needs. Attempts will be made to meet these needs. However, accommodations cannot be guaranteed in every circumstance. If you have a medical condition that requires eating at specific times, be sure and bring snacks with you.

Parking – All trips depart from the designated senior center. All centers have allocated parking zones for day trips. Check with staff in advance to verify these areas. Please secure any personal belongings that you choose to leave in your vehicle.

Georgia Takes a Stand Against Elder Abuse

Georgia public health and public safety agencies strive daily to meet citizens' needs and challenges with resources that are often stretched very thin while new issues and trends continually present themselves. One relatively new trend of increasing concern involves demographics showing that the population of citizens over age 65 is growing rapidly, while at the same time elderly citizens are being victimized at a growing rate.

Even though there have been a few sensational cases in the news, the general public remains largely unaware of the growing scope of the elder abuse situation. In order to properly address and expose growing elder abuse incidents, Georgia officials have ramped up regulatory agencies including the Division of Aging Services, Adult Protective Services (APS), and the Department of Healthcare Facility Regulation. In terms of law enforcement support, the state has recently added a new unit with eight new investigator positions in the Georgia Bureau of Investigations dedicated to investigate allegations of elder abuse in parts of the state that lack the local capacity or resources to investigate more complex or organized cases of elder abuse. Recognizing that elderly victims represent a growing class of special victims, the concerned state agencies have also begun refining the way they collaborate with counties and cities as they continue to train groups of local public safety providers in the intricacies of elder abuse investigation. Much of the training is conducted in an interactive format for groups of local public safety groups, e.g. police, sheriff, fire, EMS, and state officials provide training for professional association conferences.

Beyond focusing on elder abuse with public sector agencies, Georgia leaders recognize that the gravity and complexity of the evolving elder abuse scenario also calls for public-private partnerships and the involvement of state legislators. Thus Georgia has formed a public-private partnership known as the Georgia Council on Aging (GCA). Over the past year, the GCA has taken on a number of important initiatives designed to address various forms

of elder abuse. The council is currently working to develop a legislative proposal to establish a state registry of elder care workers in order to track abusive workers who travel from one area to another.



The hope is that in the near future, Georgia will be prepared to take its place in a national registry designed to track abusive elder care employees who travel from state to state to avoid prosecution.

At the legislative level, Georgia law makers have been working with counties and cities soliciting local input to tighten and improve laws designed to prevent and fight elder abuse. Most recently the law regulating the licensing of personal care homes was elevated to make it a felony to run an unlicensed personal care home under certain circumstances. As new proposals emanate from cities and counties, legislators encourage all stakeholders to continue to take them on and determine their appropriate place in the state legislative process.

Concerning the role of Georgia counties and cities, local partnerships and task forces comprised of prosecutors, law enforcement, bankers, fire and EMS leaders and members of senior citizen organizations have been uniting around the state in order to address mutual concerns regarding elder abuse. The premier advocacy group, the Cobb Elder Abuse Task Force, collaborates with the public and local agencies and aims to raise public awareness, simplify ways for the public to report suspected elder abuse (see tip line below), implement searches for proposals to improve legislation designed to protect the elderly, and share anecdotes and experiences concerning individual criminal investigations and prosecutions in elder abuse cases. The group's main focus has been on three general types of elder abuse: physical, institutional, and the most common type-financial abuse of the elderly.

Insofar as there are numerous groups of stakeholders concerned with the growing demographic of elderly persons and a commensurate growth in elder abuse, Georgia has seen and promoted a growing collaboration of public and private organizations with private citizens, all of whom are dedicated to working



together to meet the challenges faced by our newest cluster of special victims: senior citizens.

Heart disease is the leading cause of death for both men and women. About 1 out of 3 U.S. adults have high blood pressure and only half (47%) have it under control (CDC). As we age, our risk for high blood pressure increases, and high blood pressure increases our risk for heart disease and stroke. The good news is that you can make healthy changes to lower your risk of developing heart disease. Controlling and preventing risk factors is also important for people who already have heart disease. If you already have high blood pressure, making control your goal does not have to be a daunting task! Small, manageable steps can help you reach your goal - here are some tips from Million Hearts®, a national initiative which aims to prevent 1 million heart attacks and strokes by 2017:

Engage your health care team. Make a list of questions to take to your next visit (Ex. What is my blood pressure goal? How can I reach my goal?) Use all of your healthcare providers (nurses, pharmacist, etc.) to help you control your blood pressure.

Take your medication faithfully. Discuss side effects and treatment options with your provider - never stop treatment on your own. Try using a pill box or get smartphone "app" reminders to help you take your medications regularly.

Monitor your blood pressure, not just at your doctor's, but at home or at the pharmacy. Keep a log. 4)Make healthy choices: Start moving! Take an exercise class at your local senior center or start walking with friends.

Shop for more fresh fruit, vegetables, and whole grains and learn to read labels and choose fewer prepared foods with high sodium, cholesterol, saturated fat, and trans fat.

Sign up for a cooking class or nutrition seminar at a Cobb County Senior Center to get more tips and ideas for preparing healthier meals.

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Evidence Based Programs at Cobb Senior Services – Felicia Alingu

An evidence-based program is one that has been developed by researchers and scientifically proven to have positive benefits for participants. The programs are adapted for community organizations, and instructors must be certified to deliver the program the way it was intended so that community members have the best chance of receiving the benefits. Instructors can either be health professionals or lay leaders, who may not have medical training, but have completed a training course to be able to conduct a specific program.



Evidence-based programs make the best use of time and resources for individuals and communities because of their ability to both reduce health care costs and to improve the health status of those who participate. As members of our society become more educated about their health due to increased availability of information, and as the health industry strives to make care more efficient, the demand will increase for programs with proven results and demonstrated effectiveness through research studies. Cobb Senior Services offers a range of evidence-based programs that address different aspects of health and wellness, several of which are open to all adults and caregivers of any age. Upcoming programs are listed below:

A MATTER OF A Matter of Balance

BALANCE This falls prevention program addresses the mental, physical, and social factors that play into the fear of falling for older adults. In eight 2-hoursessions, two "coaches," or lay leaders, guide a variety of activities designed to help participants view the threat of falls as controllable, reduce risk factors for falls in their environment, and set goals to increase their strength, balance, and activity level. Adults aged 60 or older who have fallen before, restrict activity because of fear of falling, or are interested in improving their flexibility, balance, and strength are encouraged to participate in this course. According to the program developers, 97% of participants are more comfortable talking about falling, 97% feel comfortable increasing activity, and 99% plan to continue exercising. Pre-registration is required; program cost is \$30.

Stanford Chronic Disease Self Management Program

PATIENT EDUCATION This program is designed for adults with one or more chronic conditions and their RESEARCH CENTER caregivers. Participants gain confidence in controlling their symptoms and maintaining an active lifestyle with new techniques to use in tandem with their existing treatment program.

Certified lay leaders guide this highly interactive program in which participants provide each other with mutual support. Class topics include: healthy eating, appropriate use of medication, effective communication, decision-making, evaluating new treatments, and exercise to improve strength, endurance, and flexibility. This program consists of six 2.5-hour classes. Those who participate in this course can experience improvements in exercise, self-reported general health, fatigue, and a decrease in outpatient health care visits, hospitalizations, and length of hospital stays. Pre-registration is required; program cost is \$30 (includes workbook and CD).

Stanford Diabetes Self Management Program

This self management program is designed specifically for adults with type 2 diabetes and their caregivers. It is highly interactive and involves mutual support among class members. Participants will make weekly action plans, share experiences, and help each other solve problems they encounter by creating and implementing their personalized self-management program. Class topics include: techniques to deal with diabetes symptoms and manage emotional problems, healthy eating, appropriate use of medication, working effectively with healthcare providers, and exercise to maintain and improve strength and endurance. Participants in this program can experience improvements in depression, hypoglycemia symptoms, communicating with physicians, healthy eating, and reading food labels. Pre-registration is required; program cost is \$30 (includes workbook and CD).



Powerful Tools for Caregivers

This class is designed for caregivers to their loved ones. Over 6 weeks, caregivers will gain the tools to increase their own self-care, decrease negative emotions and personal stress, communicate more effectively, and make tough care-giving decisions. Participants can

experience increased self-care behaviors such as exercise and relaxation techniques, reduced negative emotions, increased utilization of available community services, and increased confidence as a caregiver.

Endomondo (iOS and Android) This app is the perfect motivator to get you moving more. You'll start by taking a fitness test to assess your fitness level, and then the app makes a suggested plan based on your favorite forms of exercise.



First Aid By American Red Cross (iOS and Android) Though not meant to substitute full CPR and first aid training or the help of a professional Healthcare provider, the app gives you access to a wealth of knowledge in case of an emergency medical situation.



Healthy Out (iOS and Android) Eating out doesn't have to be unhealthy. Just plug in your address and add filters for dietary restrictions, cuisine, ingredients, and even the type of dish you're looking for. Then the app will offer dozens of restaurants from which to choose and even note the healthiest food on their menu.



Instant Heart Rate (iOS and Android)

Using your phone's camera, this app is able to accurately take your pulse and give a real time chart of your heart rate.



Lose It (iOS and Android) Enter your weight, height, age and weight goals into Lose It! and get a personalized daily calorie-intake recommendation. Then, using the comprehensive list of foods, you track what you eat. The app then tracks this calorie budget with graphs on your homepage.



My Fitness Pal (iOS and Android) This calorie counter app helps you reach your weight loss goals. Set a daily calorie goal, and then record your daily food and exercise to make sure you stay on track.



Map My Fitness (iOS and Android) Using your phone's built in GPS, this all-in-one fitness tracker logs and records your workout. 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
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
