COBB PARKWAY / U.S. 41 AT WINDY HILL ROAD PROJECT

The improvements at the intersection of Cobb Parkway/U.S. 41 and Windy Hill Road are the final part of a major transportation project to increase safety and mobility along a 1.95-mile section of Windy Hill Road. This particular intersection has an unacceptable level of service during peak hours. In addition to lengthening the existing dual left turns on Cobb Parkway, improvements include adding:

- Dual left turn lanes on the north and south legs of Cobb Parkway
- Future queue jumper lanes for transit vehicles on the north and south legs of Cobb Parkway
- Dual southbound right turn lanes on the north leg of Cobb Parkway to Windy Hill Road westbound
- A right turn lane on the west leg of Windy Hill Road to U.S. 41 southbound
- A third northbound lane on Cobb Parkway exiting to Terrell Mill Road
- All new traffic signal equipment and pedestrian accommodations

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
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
