

CASE EVALUATOR QUALIFICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATION
(Revised July 1, 2003)

- (1) Complete the case evaluator application in the Alternative Dispute Resolution office;
- (2) Be a member in good standing of the Georgia Bar with at least 7 years of Georgia practice;
- (3) Have been lead counsel from inception to completion for a minimum of 10 cases in the Georgia Courts in each area of expertise which you would like to be certified;
- (4) Complete a minimum of 28 hours of mediation training approved by the Cobb Superior Court;
- (5) Complete a minimum of 8 hours of case evaluation training approved by the Cobb Superior Court.

The court may certify a retired or former judge of the Cobb County Superior, State, Probate, Juvenile or Chief Magistrate of the Magistrate's Court to sit as a case evaluator notwithstanding the above qualifications.
