

## **Delayed Report Instructions**

**When defendants are sentenced to serve time in the Cobb County Jail, judges may allow defendants to begin serving their times in custody at times other than when sentences are imposed. If you are to surrender yourself at a later time, the following list of guidelines will facilitate your reporting to begin serving your jail time.**

**Be on Time. Have someone drop you off so your vehicle will not be ticketed or towed. You need not bring your driver's license or any other form of ID.**

**Wear comfortable clothing and shoes with no strings, ties, or belts. Leave ALL jewelry and valuables at home; (including: piercings, watches, rings etc) NO scrunchies, rubber bands, hair pins, or hair pieces etc will be allowed in the jail.**

**NO cell phones are allowed. On a separate piece of paper write down all phone numbers you might need and bring the list with you.**

**DO NOT bring prescription medications. If you require medication, the medical staff at the jail will need a list of your medications, your doctor's information, and your pharmacy's information.**

**Bring NO outside food or drink; this includes gum, cough drops, etc. NO books or outside reading material will be allowed in the jail. You will not be allowed to bring cigarettes, cigars, or chewing tobacco. No lighters will be allowed.**

**If you are surrendering at the Cobb County Jail, bring a copy of your sentencing order with you.**

**\*\*\*\*Bring cash money ONLY if you will be incarcerated\*\*\*\*
