**Public Safety Report – Dir. Sam Heaton**

- 66 cars ordered for August, 50 more also processing – cars are helping with recruitment
- At Public Safety recruitment event 400 showed up
- Body cameras approved, applying for grant
- License plate readers on hold while privacy issues addressed
- Security in 100 Cherokee building to be improved: cameras/emergency phones in parking deck, limited access
- Safety Blitz June 6th went well, will have one in the fall at Osborne

- Conducted outreach presentation to mediators
- Working on GBI legislative team to determine legislative needs
- Organizing and setting up website

Community Awareness:

- Last presentation was May 20 on Mental Health, it went well
