PROCEDURES FOR SEWER APPROVAL ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

1. The plumbing permit shall be appropriately marked for sewer installation, by a state licensed mas-ter plumber.
2. The sewer approval affidavit shall be completely filled out before the affidavit can be accepted.
3. On New Construction, there shall not be a final plumbing inspection performed if:
 - A. The sewer approval affidavit is not attached to the plumbing permit
4. If the plumbing contractor selects a visual inspection rather than by affidavit, the trench shall be properly shored and/or sloped, in accordance with OSHA regulations and Cobb County Trenching Ordinance, until after the inspection is performed and as long as the trench is open until the trench is filled. This is on all new and sewer replacement installations.
