## **Available Adult Programs**

Cobb County' Water Efficiency Program offers complimentary programs to educate customers about drinking water, conservation, and water supply issues. We can customize a program for your group or you can choose from a readily available program. Brief descriptions are provided. **Public Water Supply Fact of Fiction:** 30-40 minutes - A presentation that addresses the common beliefs about public water supply and conservation and debunks the myths about drinking water and the roles of efficiency and new supply in meeting the region's future demands.

**Water Workshop** – 45-60 minutes – Ever wanted to know how to turn off water at your home, prevent frozen pipes, or manage your plumbing system? Wonder what your water bill means and what you are paying for? Want to lower the bill and learn how to make easy changes around your home? This is the workshop for you. Attendees also receive a free household kit they can install at home after the class.

**Conservation 101** – 30 minutes - Come find out with hands on demos how to save water. Get tips and best practices for indoor and outdoor water savings. Learn about the program opportunities we have available. Attendees receive conservation materials.

**Water Wise Household** – 30-45 minutes – A water conservation program focused on indoor water conservation and leak detection and prevention.

**Water Efficient Landscape** – 30-45 minutes – A program focused on the 7 best practices for water efficient landscapes: Design, plant selection, soil preparation, mulch, irrigation, use of turf, and maintenance. Attendees receive free outdoor kits.

**Control your Controller** – 30-45 minutes – A hands on class introducing various irrigation controllers and basic skills to program, maintain, and operate them for increased efficiency.

**Water Supply Update** – 45-60 minutes – A presentation that updates on latest water supply issues and status on: droughts, tri-state water issues, and supply challenges.

**Whadda You Know about H2O** – 30-45 minutes – A brief overview of Cobb County Water System followed by an extended Q&A session where attendees can ask questions about water system concerns.

**Sprinkler Spruce Up** - 30-45 minutes - Program on irrigation systems best practices for maintaining, managing, and scheduling irrigation.
