Press Release Information on Sewer Overflow

Cobb County, GA - Feb 5, 2019

Pursuant to the rules and Regulations for Water Quality Control, Chapter 391-3-6-05, the Georgia Environmental Protection division now requires all publicly owned wastewater treatment works that discharge to the waters of the State to provide information on sewer overflows to local media contacts as part of ongoing, comprehensive public education and awareness efforts.

A wastewater overflow occurred on: February 4, 2019

Location of overflow: 628 RIVER BEND CIR SW SMYRNA 30082

This overflow resulted from: STRUCTURAL

Corrective action taken to reduce effects of the overflow include the following:

Cut out and replaced broken section of pipe.

Field Observation:

Upon arrival, found stream crossing pipe was leaking in creek. Light grey area discharging from broken area of pipe into waterway.
