Press Release Information on Sewer Overflow

Cobb County, GA - Feb 25, 2019

Pursuant to the rules and Regulations for Water Quality Control, Chapter 391-3-6-05, the Georgia Environmental Protection division now requires all publicly owned wastewater treatment works that discharge to the waters of the State to provide information on sewer overflows to local media contacts as part of ongoing, comprehensive public education and awareness efforts.

A wastewater overflow occurred on: February 24, 2019
Location of overflow: 1001 WOOTEN LAKE RD Kennesaw 30144
This overflow resulted from: GREASE
Resulting in a wastewater discharge into: Tributary to Tate Creek
The volume of the overflow was estimated at: 350 Gallons
The Water System was notified at: Feb 24, 2019, 1:50 PM
The overflow was stopped at: Feb 24, 2019, 4:45 PM

Corrective action taken to reduce effects of the overflow include the following:

Unstop blockage with the jet machine, clean and spread lime around spill area.

Field Observation:

Upon arrival, found manhole # 312-d003 spilling with a light grey stain in an area of 15 ft X 25 ft.
