

**PUBLIC REVIEW MEETING NOTICE
FY2018 REVISED JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT ALLOCATIONS**

A Public Review Meeting will be held at **10:00 a.m.** on **Tuesday, March 5, 2019** at the **Cobb County CDBG Program Office – Conference Room** located at **192 Anderson Street, Suite 150, Marietta, Georgia 30060**, to receive comments on the amended FY2018 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) allocations.

The Bureau of Justice (BJA) published a Special Notice on Thursday, October 11, 2018, mandating the County to allocate three percent (\$3,184.56) of its FY2018 JAG funding for National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) compliance. As such, a portion of each FY2018 JAG Subrecipient’s funding will be reduced and awarded to the Cobb Police Department. Below are the revised FY2018 JAG recommended allocations:
