SENSE OF PLACE

JOSH SMALL AREA PLAN PRELIMINARY RECOMMENDATIONS

Guiding Principles:

Enhance streetscape and architectural design of buildings and create pedestrian/bike friendly streets with connected sidewalks to improve the community's sense of place.

Recommendations:

- Create Design Guidelines along Johnson Ferry Road between Post Oak Tritt and Shallowford Road and along Shallowford Road between Mabry Road and McPherson Road.
 - a. Focus on streetscape plan (consider low growth tree canopy under or near utility power lines)
 - b. Decorative lighting
 - c. Signalization (vehicular/pedestrian/bike)
 - d. Planted medians
 - e. Sidewalks and street furniture
- 2. Encourage partnerships with community based organizations to design, implement, and fund gateway markers to improve community appearances and to oversee the implementation of JOSH design guidelines.
- 3. Create a Pedestrian Lighting District within the JOSH Design Guidelines.
- 4. Explore funding options and seek alternative approaches to accomplishing the placement of utilities underground.
- 5. As part of design efforts, ensure nonconforming signs are in compliance with current regulations and any future design guidelines.
- 6. Seek developer commitments for any future design guidelines, quality architecture, landscape planting, lighting, and signage during development, rezoning, and special use permitting process.
