Press Release Information on Sewer Overflow

Cobb County, GA - May 2, 2019

Pursuant to the rules and Regulations for Water Quality Control, Chapter 391-3-6-05, the Georgia Environmental Protection division now requires all publicly owned wastewater treatment works that discharge to the waters of the State to provide information on sewer overflows to local media contacts as part of ongoing, comprehensive public education and awareness efforts.

A wastewater overflow occurred on: May 2, 2019

Location of overflow: 3844 LAUREL DR , Acworth, GA 30101

This overflow resulted from: GRAVEL

Resulting in a wastewater discharge into: Tributary to Butler Creek

The volume of the overflow was 130 Gallons

The Water System was notified at: May 2, 2019, 8:05 AM
The overflow was stopped at: May 2, 2019, 9:10 AM

Corrective action taken to reduce effects of the overflow include the following:

Unstopped overflowing manhole with jet machine. Cleaned and spread lime around the spill area.

Field Observation:

Upon our arrival, county manhole# 500-A006A was discharging from lid. This caused an area of 2 ft x 10 ft leading to the creek. No debris found only liquid.
