

## District 3 Construction Projects May 18 - May 24, 2019

### [Barrett Parkway at Bells Ferry Road](#)

This project is Substantially Complete. This project consisted of construction of dual left turn lanes from NB Bells Ferry Road onto WB Barrett Parkway, dual left turn lanes from SB Bells Ferry Road onto EB Piedmont Road, and a right turn lane from WB Piedmont Road onto NB Bells Ferry Road.

### [Bells Ferry Road Sidewalk](#)

This project consists of adding sidewalk on Bells Ferry Road, from New Chastain Road to Estates Landing Drive. This project is scheduled to be completed Summer 2019.

### [Blackwell Road at Autumn Ridge Parkway](#)

This project consists of improving sight distance and removing the existing four-way stop at the intersection of Blackwell Road and Autumn Ridge Parkway, creating a two-way stop. Additional improvements include construction of left turn lanes in both directions on Blackwell Road to Autumn Ridge Parkway, and also includes the addition of curb and gutter, with a five-foot wide sidewalk. This project is scheduled to be completed Summer 2020.

### [Blackwell Road Closure](#)

Blackwell Road will be closed to through traffic at Autumn Ridge Parkway between Canton Road and Ebenezer Road, Tuesday, May 21, 2019, weather permitting.

### [Post Oak Tritt Road at Hembree Road](#)

This project consists of constructing a roundabout at the intersection of Post Oak Tritt Road and Hembree Road. Improvements include enhanced street lighting and sidewalk ramp upgrades to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act standards. This project is scheduled to be completed Spring 2020.

### [Sandy Plains Road \(Kinjac Drive to Ebenezer Road\)](#) 🌍

The project consists of installing a raised concrete median, from Kinjac Drive to Ebenezer Road, with appropriate median cuts and access points. Other improvements include new crosswalks and pedestrian signalization, new traffic signalization, and resurfacing of Sandy Plains Road. Also included are widened sections, associated pavement markings, and signage. This project is scheduled to be completed Fall 2019.

Daily lane closures are possible in both directions between Kinjac Drive and Ebenezer Road, north of Piedmont Road. Drivers are advised to take Canton Road or Holly Springs Road as alternate routes to avoid traffic congestion. Motorists using Sandy Plains Road should reduce their speed and exercise caution in the area.

### [Shallowford Road](#) 🌍

This project consists of constructing curb and gutter with a five-foot wide sidewalk along the south side of Shallowford Road, from Georgia Northeastern Railroad Company, LLC right-of-way on Canton Road to Meadow Way. This project will provide sidewalks in the vicinity of Nicholson Elementary School and McCleskey Middle School. This project is scheduled to be completed Summer 2019.

### [Wesley Chapel Road Sidewalks](#) 🌍

This project is Substantially Complete. This project consists of adding sidewalk on the east side of Wesley Chapel Road from Spring Mill Drive to Sandy Plains Road (approximately 0.4 miles), to provide sidewalk access between Garrison Mill Elementary School, Area Subdivisions, and Mabry Park.

### [Westside Drive](#) 🌍

This project consists of constructing a roundabout at the intersection of Westside Drive and Sandtown Road, to include a new two-lane roadway with curb and gutter and sidewalk extending to South Cobb Drive. At the intersection of Westside Drive and South Cobb Drive, the Westside Drive approach will include dual left turn lanes and a right turn lane. The existing traffic signal at Beech Road and South Cobb Drive will be removed, and a new traffic signal will be installed at South Cobb Drive and Westside Drive. This project is scheduled to be completed late Summer 2019.

### [Sandtown Road – Road Closure](#) 🌍

Sandtown Road is closed to through traffic between Beech Road and Westside Drive through Wednesday, July 31, 2019, weather permitting.

## **UPCOMING PROJECTS**

### [Canton Road at Liberty Hill](#) 🌍

This upcoming project consists of intersection improvements to include construction of a southbound deceleration/right turn lane into the RaceTrac development, left turn striping into the RaceTrac development, and traffic signal modifications to the existing signal. This project is scheduled to begin Summer 2019.

## [Old Hwy 41 Bridge over CSX Railroad](#)

This upcoming project consists of a complete bridge replacement of the existing bridge located on Old 41 Highway over the CSX Railroad, near the intersection of Bells Ferry Road. This project is scheduled to begin Summer 2019.

## **GDOT PROJECTS**

### **GDOT Resurfacing I-75 & I-285**

This GDOT project consists of resurfacing I-75 from the Chattahoochee River to just north of Allgood Road; I-285 eastbound from Cobb Parkway to just west of the Chattahoochee River Bridge; and all ramps and CD Lanes not included in the Northwest Corridor project. Expect lane closures from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. This work is weather and temperature dependent.

### **GDOT Resurfacing SR 280/South Cobb Drive**

This GDOT project consists of resurfacing South Cobb Drive from the Austell Road to Franklin Gateway. Expect lane closures from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. This work is weather and temperature dependent.
