



#### Super Bowl Review

Atlanta hosted the NFL Super Bowl at Mercedes Benz Stadium in downtown Atlanta on February 3, 2019. Over 150 jet aircraft were parked on the airport during peak hours. Through the event weekend 900 flights operated from the airport with arrivals and departures every 2.5 minutes during the peak hours. 

- TOTAL TRAFFIC


**COBB'S (KRYV) MONTHLY TOTAL TRAFFIC**

# IV. OLD BUSINESS

## A. ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

- **Environmental Assessment (EA) must be completed prior to construction of Federally Funded Master Plan Projects**
- **Scope of Services for EA has been APPROVED by the State/FAA.**
- **Scope includes the first 10-years of projects.**
- **State/FAA approved FEE proposal of \$178,600**
- **BOC Approved Agreement on August 28, 2018, and Agreement is fully executed.**

**90% Federal Funding Grant Agreement EXECUTED.**

**NTP issued November 8<sup>th</sup>.**

# IV. OLD BUSINESS

## A. ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

10 Month Schedule – Target September 30, 2019

**Current Status:** Draft EA Study submitted for review to County and State in preparation for submittal to Agencies. State to return comments June 4<sup>th</sup>.

**Next Phase:** Submit EA to Federal Agencies for Review and open conversation with Vulcan Quarry regarding Bridging Quarry Edge for future Taxiway A relocation.

- **Wildlife / Biologic survey completed.** No protected species collected.
- **Ecology fieldwork / wetland / stream delineation completed:** some impacts anticipated and mitigation to be proposed.
- **Bat habitat survey completed:** Avoid tree clearing from April to October 15.
- **Cultural resources survey** - no archaeological or architectural resources identified
- **Air quality assessment** findings indicate that the operational and construction-related emissions are within the regulatory thresholds (i.e., no impacts).

## B. MALSF – Approach Light Project

MALSF successfully completed a preliminary flight check.

NCP Review Panel held hearing 9-25-18. Approved with One item to close within 7 days.


FAA Regional Administrator has been engaged and he has been responsive.

GaPower engaged.

LATEST: GaPower contract executed for installation of additional marker balls. Work being scheduled with GaPower, expectation late June.

Activation is pending, installation of marker balls, FAA review board approval and FAA flight check approval. We anticipate that certification may be complete by September.


State requested RYY Bid Project to compete for FAA Grant:

Project is competing for FAA Discretionary Grant that could be awarded as late as September



Depending upon paperwork, construction could begin as late as Spring 2020

ARFF Site: Plans updated to include 25k sqft hangar site ready pad



- Estimate Spring 2021 operational date



- Airport investigatin awarding lease to continue ministorage operations after purchase




