Press Release Information on Sewer Overflow

Cobb County, GA - Jul 26, 2019

Pursuant to the rules and Regulations for Water Quality Control, Chapter 391-3-6-05, the Georgia Environmental Protection division now requires all publicly owned wastewater treatment works that discharge to the waters of the State to provide information on sewer overflows to local media contacts as part of ongoing, comprehensive public education and awareness efforts.

A wastewater overflow occurred on: July 25, 2019

Location of overflow: 1638 REX DR, MARIETTA, GA 30066

This overflow resulted from: GRAVEL

Resulting in a wastewater discharge into: Tributary to Morgan Lake

The volume of the overflow was

The overflow was stopped at: Jul 25, 2019, 12:45 PM

Corrective action taken to reduce effects of the overflow include the following:

Used jet machine to unstop blockage from manhole #309-B037. Cleaned and spread potpourri around spill area.

Field Observation:

Upon arrival, found lid in place and a small area on the ground was wet. No solids found on ground or in the creek.
