



**MULTI-USE TRAILS**

The Price Property has more than 150 acres of wooded area and is located in West Cobb County. The site features gently rolling terrain with the opportunity to provide natural multi-use trails. The conceptual master plan shows approximately 7 miles of multi-purpose trails throughout the property for walking, jogging and biking or other passive recreational uses.



**MULTI-USE TRAILS**

The Natural Trails are a system of paths that meander through some of the most beautiful natural areas within the park. The trails wind around the natural topography along Allatoona Creek, and through the hills and rock outcroppings on the property. Trails would provide opportunities for hiking, plant walks and wildlife viewing, with specific trails designated for an arboretum and plant rescue. Trails will be designed to have minimal impact on the surrounding environment, incorporate best management practices and will utilize low-impact materials.



**BIKE TRAILS**

Bike trails are proposed for the areas north of the power easement. The bike trails will provide additional opportunities in the area for riders of all skill levels. This master plan currently shows approximately 3.8 miles of biking trails and has the potential to connect to a larger biking trail system in the future.



**BIKE TRAILS:**

The bike trails will include biking trails for beginners to more experienced riders. A half mile pump track is shown on the master plan within the power easement on some of the most challenging topography on the property. The pump track will provide a great use of this property and will appeal to a wide variety of skilled riders.



**NATURAL VEGETATION**

Native plants have adapted to the local conditions of the area and provide vital habitat for birds and many other species of wildlife. They also require far less water and maintenance to grow and thrive. Native plant rescue is a great community service that will attract volunteer groups to become active participants in the evolution of the park.



**COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT**

Volunteers are encouraged to help facilitate programs at Cobb County Parks. Plant rescue programs are an integral part of the Georgia Native Plant Society and their purpose is to rescue native plants that are in the direct path of development. The Price Property offers a place to relocate plants to establish a natural habitat to attract birds and wildlife and plant native trees and eventually to create an attractive arboretum.
