

**PUBLIC REVIEW MEETING NOTICE
PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT
COBB COUNTY PROGRAM YEAR 2019 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

A Public Review Meeting will be held at **11:00 a.m.** on **Thursday, September 5, 2019** at the **Stratton Branch Library** located at **1100 Powder Springs Road, Marietta, GA 30064** to receive comments on the amended allocations for the final Program Year (PY) 2019 HOME Investment Partnerships Act (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs.

The CDBG Program Office identified a slight miscalculation in the allocation percentages for the HOME Investment Partnerships Act (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs. As such, the CDBG Program Office is recommending a revision to the following funding lines:

HOME AMENDMENTS

- City of Roswell's CHDO Program activities will be increased by \$0.01.
- City of Roswell's CHDO Operating activities will be increased by \$0.01.
- City of Roswell's Acquisition & Rehabilitation activities will be decreased by \$0.03.
- City of Roswell's HOME Program Administration allocation to Cobb County will be increased by \$0.01.

ESG AMENDMENTS

- Zion Keepers, Inc.'s Homelessness Prevention activities will be increased by \$0.01.
- Cobb County's ESG Program Administration allocation will be decreased by \$0.01.

This Amendment is classified as substantial and warrants a Public Review Meeting and 30-day Public Comment period. A 30-day Public Comment period commences on Monday, August 26, 2019 and concludes on Wednesday, September 25, 2019.
