Press Release Information on Sewer Overflow

Cobb County, GA - Sep 10, 2019

Pursuant to the rules and Regulations for Water Quality Control, Chapter 391-3-6-05, the Georgia Environmental Protection division now requires all publicly owned wastewater treatment works that discharge to the waters of the State to provide information on sewer overflows to local media contacts as part of ongoing, comprehensive public education and awareness efforts.

A wastewater overflow occurred on: September 8, 2019

Location of overflow: 164 PORT PATRICK LN SE, Mableton, GA 30126

This overflow resulted from: GREASE

Resulting in a wastewater discharge into: Tributary to Nickajack creek

The volume of the overflow was 210 Gallons

The Water System was notified at: Sep 8, 2019, 5:40 PM
The overflow was stopped at: Sep 8, 2019, 7:25 PM

Corrective action taken to reduce effects of the overflow include the following: Unstopped the blockage with the jet machine, cleaned and washed down road.

Field Observation:

Upon arrival, found the manhole spilling into a nearby storm drain with the lid in place.
