



TOTAL TRAFFIC




• IFR TRAFFIC

A. ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

Current Status: 2nd set of State comments have been addressed and the EA has been re-submitted to State for submittal to Federal Agencies.

Next Phase: Reply to second round of State Comments and distribute for Agency Coordination in January.


Target Completion: June 2020

- Wildlife / Biologic survey completed. No protected species collected.
- **Ecology fieldwork / wetland / steam delineation completed:** some impacts anticipated and mitigation to be proposed.
- Bat habitat survey completed: Avoid tree clearing from April to October 15.
- Cultural resources survey no archaeological or architectural resources identified
- Air quality assessment findings indicate that the operational and constructionrelated emissions are within the regulatory thresholds (i.e., no impacts).

B. Taxiway A Relocation Project


- Vulcan Quarry anticipates being able to cooperate with land intrusion:
 - Maintain 400' separation standard (bridge quarry edge)
 - \$5 million annual budget (\$20 million planning budget)
 - Discussion with FBO regarding Lease Premises impacts
 - Airport Engineers developing Preliminary Planning Scope of Work
 - Develop Project detail estimate
 - Develop Project Construction Phasing considering funding limitations


