Lifeguarding Prerequisites

To be eligible for the Lifeguarding course, the participant must be 15 years of age by the final class meeting and must successfully complete the following prerequisites:

- Swim 300 yards continuously using front crawl with rhythmic breathing and breaststroke.
- → Starting in water, swim 20 yards in front crawl or breaststroke, surface dive 7-10 ft, retrieve a 10-pound object, return to surface, swim 20 yds back to the start with object, and exit water without using a ladder. (time limit: 1 min, 40 sec)
- + Tread water for 2 min using only your legs (hands must be kept under armpits).

Lifeguard Recertification (\$100.00) A fee of \$62.00 is due when you register for the class —payable to P.A.R.K.S. An additional \$38.00 fee must be paid directly to the American Red Cross. Details will be given on how to pay this portion of the fee at the first class meeting.

Review classes are available for those students that are currently Lifeguard certified and are about to expire. After successful completion of this course, participants will be certified for two (2) years in the following: Lifeguarding, First Aid, and CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer (C-PRO)
