

## CITY OF SMYRNA NOTICE FOR A GENERAL ELECTION

The City of Smyrna, Georgia will hold a General Election on TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2019, to elect the following positions: **Mayor**, elected at large, and **Council Member Wards 1-7**. For each office, the candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast shall be elected. Where no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast, a Runoff election shall be held on **DECEMBER 3, 2019**. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and the election will be held at the following polling places:

**Qualifying for candidates** will open Tuesday, August 20, 2019 and close on Thursday, August 22, 2019. The hours for qualifying shall be between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. each day, but will close for a one (1) hour lunch break from 12:00 noon until 1:00 p.m. Qualifying shall be held in the Human Resources Room at the Smyrna City Hall, 2800 King St., Smyrna GA. Each candidate must meet the qualifications for office as prescribed by State Law and Municipal Code. Each candidate or his or her designee shall file a Notice of Candidacy and Affidavit, such form is available at [www.sos.ga.gov](http://www.sos.ga.gov) and will also be provided at the qualifying location. The qualifying fee shall be payable by cash, check, or money order made out to the City of Smyrna in the following amount:

**Residents of the City of Smyrna** may register to vote through the close of business Tuesday, October 7, 2019. Those who are qualified to register to vote for this election may do so by clicking "Register to Vote" at [www.sos.ga.gov/elections](http://www.sos.ga.gov/elections) or by appearing in person at any of the designated places for registering Cobb County residents or the Smyrna City Clerk's Office. If you have moved into, out of, or within the city limits of Smyrna and have not notified the Cobb Board of Elections and Registration, please do so no later than October 7, 2019.

**Advance Voting** will be available Monday through Friday from **October 14, 2019 through November 1, 2019** during the hours of **8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** in the Elections and Registration office located at West Park Government Center, 736 Whitlock Avenue, Marietta, GA 30064.

**Additional Advance Voting locations** will be available **October 28, 2019 through November 1, 2019** during the hours of **9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** Voters may vote at any of the following locations:

Mail-in ballots must be received by 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, November 5, 2019 either through the mail or personally delivered to the Cobb County Elections Office.
