EARLY PROCESSING OF ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Pursuant to State Election Board Emergency Rule 183-1-14-0.7-15, Cobb County intends to begin processing absentee ballots cast for the June 9, 2020 Primary and Election beginning on Monday, June 1, 2020. The opening of ballot envelopes and scanning of ballots will begin each day at 8:00 AM and conclude at 5:00 PM until completed. A sign will be posted on the front door notifying the public if there is any change to this schedule or if activities are suspended for any period. This activity will be take place at the Board of Elections Main Office, 736 Whitlock Ave., Marietta GA 30064.

Early processing of absentee ballots shall be controlled, such that ballot secrecy is maintained. The collection or disclosure of any balloting information before the close of the polls at 7:00 P.M. on Election Day is strictly prohibited. Any members of the public who wish to observe will be required to check-in, receive a badge, take an oath, and relinquish cell phones or other electronic recording devices prior to viewing this process.
