- Discovery Boulevard – bids received last week, meeting today to bring under budget. Pre-fab restroom facility, parking, trails.

- Mud Creek Soccer Complex – contracts in place, hope to start construction next week, seal coat, some pothole patching
- O.C. Hubert – paving and asphalt repair, seal coat
- Roofing replacements at 21 facilities – 2 groups for 2 bids to make a smoother process, most are currently shingled, to be replaced with standing seam metal roofs, this will complete all buildings.
- LED lighting upgrades at Lost Mountain, Fair Oaks, Wildhorse Creek, Fullers & West Cobb Aquatic
- Shade structures – Pitner, Lost Mountain and Sewell
- Plumbing upgrades – Pitner and Allatoona Creek
- Larry Bell Complex – sewer rehab design, 90% complete, to be installed parallel to old line, about 9 months to complete
- Fullers synthetic fields – design near completion; LED light replacement approved by BOC
- Jim Miller Event Center – security bollards installed
- Award recognizing work at Green Meadows
