IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Registration

The **total registration fee** is due at time of registration, partial payments will not be accepted and due to county policy no checks may be held. If for any reason your team is not accepted a full refund will be made immediately. Refunds will not be given once the league schedules are completed.

Make **checks payable to: Cobb PARKS**. Checks returned unpaid by the bank will be charged a \$35.00 fee. We also accept VISA, AMEX, Discover Card and MasterCard.

All spots are filled on a first come first serve basis. Schedule conflicts **must be submitted at registration**. **We do not guarantee that all conflict requests will be honored.**

A \$35 non-residency fee will be charged to any team that does not meet the residency requirements.

FOR ONLINE REGISTRATIONS - If the person that registers the team online is **not a Cobb resident** the \$35.00 additional fee will automatically be added. If your team meets the residency requirements please contact your league coordinator for payment.

ADA - It is the intent of Cobb County Government to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you or anyone on your team has a specific physical or service accessibility need please make our staff aware so that we may make a reasonable effort to accommodate your needs.

Season

LEAGUE PLAY:

Al Bishop Complex – games may begin Thursday, August 20th.

Game Times – Games will be scheduled to begin as early as 6:30 p.m. and as late as 8:30 p.m. during the week. The number of teams in each league will determine start time.

League Information - The PARKS Department will furnish cornhole boards and bags. Teams may bring their own bags. Teams must have a minimum of 2 players present each week but can have more players on their team if they wish up to 5 players. This is a mixed doubles league where teams may consist of a mix of male and female players. Leagues will be divided into two divisions:

- Beginner – hits the board a few times and occasionally hits the hole
- Intermediate – hits the board consistently and a few in the hole

League Format – Leagues will play a minimum of 7 games/series plus a single elimination post season tournament. The number of teams in each division will determine the league and playoff structure. League winners will receive championship shirts. Teams will play a best of 3 series each week. Make-up games will be determined by league coordinator and could include playing on different nights. The schedule may also include double headers. Al Bishop may be closed Thursday, September 24th and Thursday, October 1st due to the North Georgia State Fair.

Individual Registration – Individual registration is \$45 and this fee covers all games. Registering as an individual does not guarantee you a place on a team. If there are not enough registrants to create a team, your registration fees will be refunded.



ONLINE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS



Go to the PARKS home page, www.cobbparks.org, and click on the 'Register Online' button. To log-in, simply enter your email address then just click on "Forgot My Password" and click Continue. An email will be sent to you providing you with a temporary password. If you receive an error message stating that the system cannot locate your email, you can easily create a new account by following these simple steps:

1. Click on the Create an Account link.
2. Fill out the form for New Account Request completely; including all required fields (Birth Date, Gender, Email Address, etc.) and click submit. Please submit your request only once.

You must have an account created in the new registration system prior to being allowed to register for fall activities. If you have an existing account it is likely we do not currently have your birth date and this is required in the new system as many classes, memberships and fees are based on age.

RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

PERMISSION TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL TREATMENT

Realizing the nature of this program, its physical demands and how important it is to follow rules, regulations, and instructions outlined by the staff of the Cobb County Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs department, I am, to the best of my knowledge, in good health and able to participate in the program. I authorize the staff of the Cobb County Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs Department to organize any required medical or first aid procedure, or to take the undersigned to a hospital emergency room for treatment. If any treatment is required, I understand that every effort will be made to notify the individual indicated as emergency contact beforehand by telephone.

The above signed hereby forever releases, discharges, and covenants to hold harmless the Cobb County Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs Department, the Cobb County recreation Commission, the Cobb Arts Commission, the Cobb County Board of Commissioners and Cobb County, Georgia and any other person, firm, or corporation charged or chargeable with responsibility or liability, their heirs, administrators, executors, successors, and assignees from any and all claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses, loss of services, actions and causes of action belonging to the undersigned or arising out of any act or occurrence in connection with and particularly on account of all personal injury disability, property damage, loss of damages of any kind sustained or that may hereafter be sustained arising out of the matters described herein or in consequence of the participation in the recreation program sponsored by the Cobb County Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs Department. The undersigned hereby bind their heirs, administrators, executors and successors. Further, this Agreement shall apply to all unknown and unanticipated injuries and damages directly or indirectly resulting here-from. This Release and Hold Harmless Agreement shall constitute a full and complete release of any and all claims.
