

Cobb County Green School Initiative's *Green Innovation* Award

The Green Innovation Award will recognize one school each year that has gone above and beyond the Gold Medal requirements of the Green School Initiative to create an innovative environmental program for its students and/or community.

Who may participate:

Any Cobb County school that has also met the criteria to be designated a Gold Medal Award Green School during the same period as the Innovation Award application is submitted.

Timeline:

Each school wishing to participate will submit an application, along with a recommendation letter from a school administrator, which will be reviewed and judged by the Green School partners. Deadline for submission will be 5pm on the last school day in March. The winner will be announced in April and will be recognized in the final Green School report. A plaque will be presented to the school before the end of the school year.

Criteria:

Entries will be judged based on:

- Creativity / innovation
- Faculty and staff participation
- Number of students / community members reached
- Overall impact of the program
