



## DISPOSSESSORY SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE

While the statewide judicial emergency is still in effect for some purposes, the Fourth Order Extending Declaration of Statewide Judicial Emergency reimposed deadlines on litigants as of July 14, 2020. Therefore, if you are served on or after July 14, 2020, you MUST answer as required by law and explained in the Summons. You will receive a hearing notice with a court date after the Answer is filed.

**If you do not answer on or before the seventh day after service, a Writ of Possession may be issued without a hearing, and a judgment against you for money damages may be entered.**

### General Safety Guidelines for the Courthouse during COVID-19 Pandemic

A mask or face covering is required to enter the courthouse. Your temperature may be taken upon entry. Please maintain social distancing at all times. Please do not appear in person if you are sick or have been in contact with someone known or suspected to be positive for COVID-19.

- Have you had a recent onset of coughing?
- Have you had any recent difficulty breathing?
- Have you been around anyone who has been outside of the country in the last 14 days, or
- Have you been around anyone who has been diagnosed with or is under investigation for potential COVID-19 infection?
